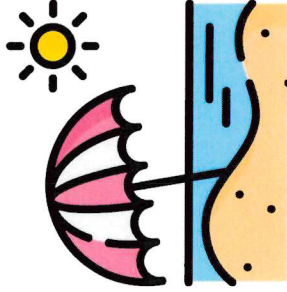


5th GRADE SUMMER BINGO
